# Metaphors



A metaphor is a device of language in which one subject is stated to be another so that a quality of that subject is described.



*'That policewoman is gold.'*

*'That policewoman is valuable. She is gold.'*



We understand that this metaphor describes the policeman as being valuable because we know gold is valuable.

# Metaphors



To create a metaphor for a subject.

1. Think of the quality of that subject you want to describe.
2. Think of another subject that is known for showing that quality.
3. Write that the first subject is the second subject.

# Metaphors

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3. Write that the first subject is the second subject.



1. Subject: A student. Quality: Strong.
2. Subject known to be Hardworking: A bull.
3. Metaphor *'That student is a hardworking bull.'*
