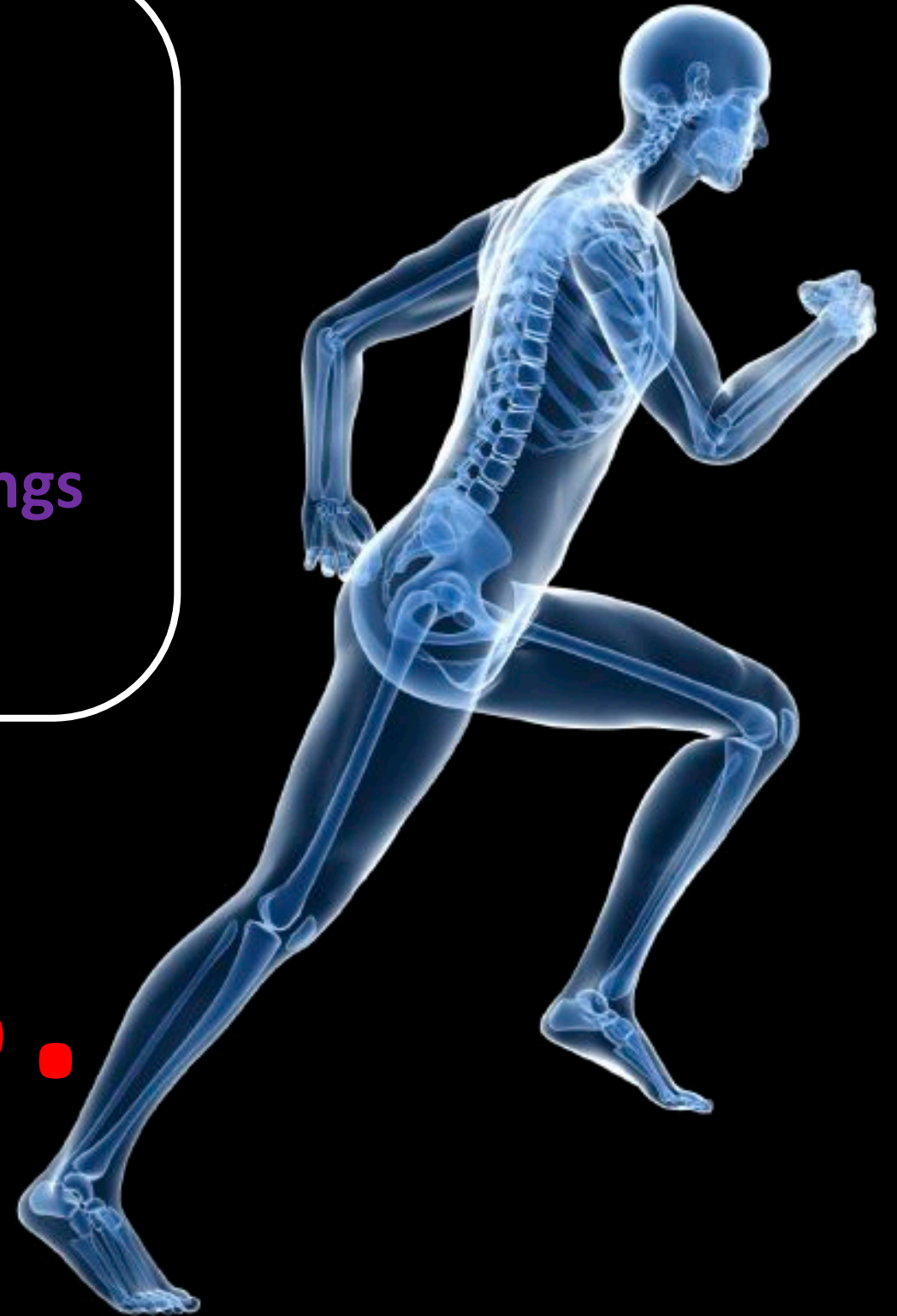


**All sentence hold space and time.**
